ATTENDANCE: The following people were in attendance: Kate Mulder, Nancy Campbell, Brenda O'Neill-Smith, and Jan Duffy.

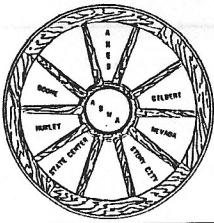
BUSINESS:
