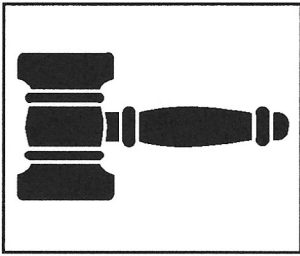

**Public Relations:** The National Chapter Public Relations Program will be giving up to \$500 per chapter to recruit new members. The Deadline is August 31, 1995.

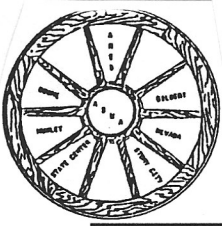
**Scholarship:** There will still be a September "Annual Fund Raiser" at Jan Duffy's house.
