Our membership approved a proposed change to the Ames Chapter Bylaws (see below for the language) at our July meeting.

Every attempt will be made to fill officer positions so that no officer shall serve more than two [2] consecutive terms in the same office. However, due to the limited number of active members, any officer position, except the Treasurer, may be filled with a member who has already served two [2] consecutive terms in the same office. (Chapter approved)

The bylaws, including the change, were sent to National for their approval. National's Executive Committee prefers the following language to the change we submitted:

No officer shall be eligible to serve more than two [2] consecutive terms in the same office, except when, after diligent recruitment efforts have failed to secure a new candidate and when the continuity of the Chapter is at risk. This exception shall not apply to the position of Treasurer. (From National)

The language proposed by National will be presented for a membership vote at the September meeting, following the 30-day notice to members sent by email on July 30, 2021.
