CHANGES TO CHAPTER BYLAWS

We received an update from National about the bylaws amendments that passed at the National meeting in October. We need to modify our bylaws to make them consistent with National. As we do this, we also need to make a decision as a chapter about what to do with the chapter dues for Emeritus members. The draft bylaws you are reviewing have treated the Emeritus members the same as Honorary members – we waive the chapter dues. Of course, we could keep them the same as for other members or reduce them to something between full and zero.

Our bylaws say that members must have 30-days' notice so any vote on these changes will be taken in March at the earliest.

Below is a summary of the changes and the attached document is a draft of our revised chapter bylaws reflecting these changes: Formatting will be cleaned up in the final copy before it is posted to the web site.

- Proposed Amendment #2 Amend Article II; Article III Section 1 E 1 and 2, Section 5B; Article IV Section 2B; Article V Section 1, Section 5, Section 9, Section 10; Article VII Section 1, Section 2; Article VIII Section 1A, Section 3; Article IX; Article XI to replace "Society" with "organization"
- Proposed Amendment #3-Amend Article XI Dissolution – Update the name to "The Foundation of Accounting & Financial Women's Alliance" from "ASWA Educational Foundation".
- Proposed Amendment #4-Article III
 Members Section 1 to add the word "five" to "six"
- Proposed Amendment #5 Amend Article III,
 Section 1 to add F. Emeritus Member
- Proposed Amendment #6 to Amend Article III, Section 1.B. Associate – 1.
 Qualifications – a. insert the word "finance", strike "a related field" and add "its equivalent"

We had made the change from "society" to "organization" when we modified our bylaws last year and we also changed the name of the foundation.

The proposed amendment about retired members did not pass.



We will be voting on a change to the standing rules in the coming months and want to get the proposed change out to members for your consideration.

The current rule:

"The incoming Chapter president shall be responsible for purchasing the outgoing president's gift after notification and approval by the Board and shall present the President's gift at the time of installation of officers."

The proposed change is to replace "incoming Chapter president" with " immediate past Chapter president".
