MINUTES – March 2015

Agenda:

President Theresa Samson noted that two additional items needed to be added to the agenda under New Business. Those were 25th Anniversary and the AFWA Springfield Conference. Motion made to adopt the revised agenda, motion seconded, motion carried.

Minutes:

The February minutes were available for all to read. Motion made that the February minutes be approved, motion seconded, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

Ann Kurtenbach handed out the February 2015 treasurer's report. The balance in the General Account as of 2/28/15 is \$7,971.57. The balance in the Scholarship Account as of 2/28/15 is \$1,952.33. Interest income was reported for both the General Account and Scholarship Account in February. \$13.58 in speaker meal expenses were also paid from the General Account. The report was placed on file for review.

Committee Reports:

- A. Membership:
 - a.) Elizabeth Bruns reported that we currently have 34 members on our member spreadsheet, including a new member from Houson, TX that is in error.
 - b.) Margaret Munson reported that we actually have 31 members, subtracting out lapsed members and the two members from Texas.
