#### Call to Order:

The February Membership Meeting of the Ames Chapter #158 was called to order by President Elizabeth Almond at 7:32 p.m. on Wednesday, February 21, 2018, at The Iowa Stater in Ames, Iowa. A quorum was present.

#### Minutes:

Karen Jacobson moved that the minutes of the November meeting be approved as presented in the February bulletin. The motion was seconded by Catherine Mulder. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:



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Catherine Mulder presented the Treasurer's Report. The November, December, and January reports were handed out.

The balance in the General Account as of November 30, 2017, is \$6,897.86. The balance in the Scholarship Account as of November 30, 2017, is \$4,015.81 with an unrestricted balance of \$1,415.81.

The balance in the General Account as of December 31, 2017, is \$6,998.15. The balance in the Scholarship Account as of December 31, 2017, is \$5,615.99 with an unrestricted balance of \$2,515.99. Member donations of \$1,650 (\$500 for the Kathy Strum scholarship) were added as income to the scholarship account this month. Way to go!

The balance in the General Account as of January 31, 2018, is \$6,998.44. The balance in the Scholarship Account as of January 31, 2018, is \$5,616.22 with an unrestricted balance of \$2,516.22. \$3,100 is restricted for the Kathy Strum scholarship.

The reports will be placed on file for review.
