Diane Janvrin, PhD, CPA, CMA, CIA is an associate professor of accounting and holds the William L. Varner Professorship. Diane teaches and researches in the areas of auditing and information systems. She currently edits the Journal of Information Systems including its special issue on implications of cybersecurity for accounting.

She has been published in Journal of Information Systems, Auditing, International Journal of Accounting Information Systems, Behavioral Research in Accounting, Accounting Horizons, Accounting and the Public Interest, Research in Accounting Regulation, and Information and Management. Diane is a member of the AAA and the ISCPA. Diane earned her PhD from the University of Iowa.
