Iowa Farmland Values

- Presenter: Michael D. Duffy, PhD Professor Emeritus Iowa State University Department of Economics

Dr. Michael D. Duffy is an Economics Professor Emeritus at Iowa State University. He was an Extension Economist and Professor of Economics. Other positions at Iowa State include: 19 years as Director of the Beginning Farmer Center, 12 years as Associate Director of the Leopold Center for Sustainable Agriculture, four years as Director of Graduate Education and two years as Chair for the Graduate Program in Sustainable Agriculture. As an Extension Economist, Dr. Duffy was responsible for the annual Iowa State University land value survey. He conducted the Iowa Farmland Ownership and Tenure survey and he was chair of the Farm Study group that planned the ISU Soil Management and Land Valuation Conference, the longest running conference at Iowa State. His farmland research included determinants of land prices, changing characteristics of Iowa farmland owners, impact of soil erosion on land values, and return to land ownership relative to alternative investments

Learning Objectives & Program Content:

This program will be a discussion on farmland values in Iowa and the possible impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. There will be four components. First will be a presentation on historical trends and returns to land, followed by a discussion on the current situation, the COVID-19 impacts and finally, implications of these impacts.

Takeaways:

- Gain a greater understanding of farmland ownership trends, reasons for ownerships and returns to ownership
- Land investment decision factors in the current pandemic
