Happy New Year! It's July again and, 2020-2021 is the start of our 30th year as a chapter. This chapter year promises a continuation of the special challenges we have been facing since the start of the calendar year. This chapter exists for us to draw support from and to provide support for each other, personally and professionally. Thank you.

Our meetings have historically had three main components: professional development through leadership and networking opportunities in the organization, professional development through continuing professional education (CPE), and social.
